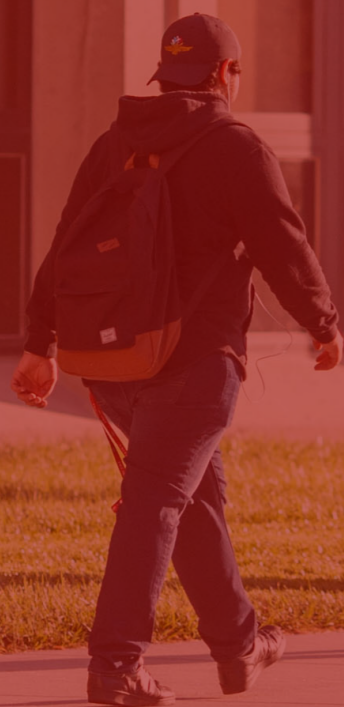

WHY BE CAR-FREE?

SAVE MONEY

Being car-free allows you to spend less (or nothing!) on campus parking fees and gas.

SAVE TIME

Ever been passed by a bike in the bike lane while stuck in traffic? That could be you!

SAVE THE PLANET

Choosing to practice car-free methods as much as possible will reduce your personal carbon emissions. Think what could happen if we all did this!

WHITE RIVER TRAIL

North-South Trail
Connecting you to the Zoo, White River State Park, and more

FALL CREEK TRAIL

NE-SW Trail
Connecting you to the Monon Trail, Northside, and more

INDY CULTURAL TRAIL

City-wide attractions trail
Connecting you to all downtown districts and attractions

BIKE



Did you know that it only takes 10 minutes to go from one side of campus to the other on a bike vs. a 30 minute walk?

RIDE LIKE A PRO

IUPUI and the City of Indianapolis feature miles of bike lanes and roads. Click this text for a campus bike map!

BE SAFE: GEAR UP

Safety first! Make sure you've got the essentials like a helmet, bike lock, visible clothing, and lights if you plan on riding at night.

DON'T HAVE A BIKE?

Not a problem! You can use the Pacer Bikeshare stations on and off campus to get from Point A to B.

BIKEABLE SPOTS (~30 MIN)

In addition to being able to bike all of the walkable spots in over half the time, you can also bike to:

FOUNTAIN SQUARE

Food, entertainment, shopping

SPEEDWAY, INDIANA

Museums, food, IMS

WHERE DO I PUT MY BIKE?

Lots of bike racks are on campus, and you can view them here. Registered bikes can have access to the Tower Garage Bike Storage Room.

GOT A BIKE? REGISTER IT!

Bike registration is free, doesn't expire, and can help identify your bike if it gets lost.

BUS

Looking to travel somewhere far away? With the JagLine and IndyGo busses running throughout campus, traveling throughout the city is a breeze!

IUPUI JagLINE

WHAT IS IT?

The JagLINE is a free shuttle service taking students to various points on the IUPUI campus.

HOW DO I USE IT?

Just get on! It's that simple! To get off at a stop, pull the yellow stop cord to alert the driver to stop.

WHAT ARE THE ROUTES?

Route maps can be found in the JagLine app or at parking.iupui.edu

BUS TO BASKETBALL

Even though Men's Basketball games are off-campus, shuttles are available to the Indiana State Fairgrounds for each home game.

IndyGo Busses and BRT

WHAT IS IT?

IndyGo is Indy's citywide bus system with numerous routes taking you all over the city. IndyGo's BRT, or Bus Rapid Transit, does the same with dedicated lanes for fast travel!

HOW DO I USE IT?

For a standard IndyGo bus, you pay as you board the bus. For BRT like the Red Line, you pay at the station. You can pay with cash, a bus pass, or with the MyKey mobile app.

WHAT ARE THE ROUTES?

IndyGo S-PASS

Did you know that students can get unlimited IndyGo rides for a month at a time?

Pick up an S-Pass in the Parking and Transportation Office and get going!

CARPOOL & MORE

Traveling sustainably alone is cool, but traveling sustainably with friends is even cooler! Plus, did you know that bikes are just one of the many ways you can quickly get across campus?

CARPOOL OPTIONS

HOOSIER RIDEBOARD

Open for all IUPUI students, faculty, and staff, you can make a profile and connect for single or routine trips.

COMMUTER CONNECT

A service by CIRT, you can connect with people for carpools to IUPUI and other employers. They also provide an emergency ride home!

IUPUI CARPOOL PERMIT

IUPUI employees can get an IUPUI Carpool permit if they sign up with at least one other employee.

NOT JUST BIKES: MICROMOBILITY

In addition to bikes, there are other ways to get around on the trails! These types of mini-vehicles are in a category known as **micromobility**.

SCOOTERS

Electric scooters offered around town are quick ways to get around. Be sure to use them responsibly!

SKATE/LONGBOARDS

Want to take your ride with you? Skateboards and longboards are portable means to get around. Like scooters, use them responsibly!

ROLLERSKATES

An even more portable way to move throughout campus or the city. Along with scooters and skateboards, be responsible on the road.

LONG DISTANCE TRAVEL

UNION STATION

Located downtown, Union Station is 30 minute walk/10 minute ride from the Campus Center. Here, you can connect to Amtrak or Greyhound busses.

AMTRAK

The Cardinal stops at Union Station 3 times a week and goes to cities throughout the midwest and beyond.

GREYHOUND

The Greyhound Bus Depot at Union Station can take you to local spots like Bloomington or South Bend and to other large cities nationwide.

HOOSIER RIDE

Offered by Miller Transportation, Hoosier Ride is a charter service with stops at the Greyhound Station and the Airport. This service can connect you to smaller towns and cities throughout Indiana.

INDIANAPOLIS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

The Indianapolis Intl' Airport is accessible by rideshare or by taking a bus via IndyGo Route 8. Nearby stops are Washington/Harding and the Transit Center.
